

6th Form attendance

All Sixth Form students must attend morning registration as followed by the rest of the school. Parents must make contact with the school if their child is absent. Students who do not attend will be marked absent.

Students must maintain an attendance percentage of above 95, those that do not will be monitored by the IBCP coordinator. Students who's attendance falls lower than 90% will meet formally with their parents/ careers/ guardians, the IBCP coordinator and Assistant Headteacher and be placed on a formal attendance monitoring program. Should their attendance fail to improve students, parents/ careers/ guardians will meet again with the IBCP coordinator and Assistant Headteacher to discuss the attendance further.

Regular attendance to school allows students to achieve and gives them the best opportunities in further life. Students who's attendance is above 95% have the chance to develop skills and qualities that will support them in their future.
